My credit has never been that good.

Because of my credit being excellent, I was able to get an apartment. I also have a job where everyone is close like family, and I can share the Gospel of Jesus Christ freely without losing my job.

These are just a small portion of the blessings that God has blessed me with, but my favorite one is the family that I gained through the ministry.
